

GROWING TOGETHER IN RWANDA

Ways to get involved

- Read Elizabeth's blog (online journal) while she's away and send her email notes, however short
- Read the blog print-outs, available in the meeting house
- Collect unwanted flash drives/ data sticks/ USB sticks for Elizabeth to give away
- Collect specific gifts– e.g. children's books for the Peace Library, good quality children's clothes
- Help develop display material
- Teach Elizabeth better photo editing skills
- Elizabeth could give talks, eg schools, church groups – do you know of any groups who would welcome this?
- Host a small group of Quaker or other friends in your home as an opportunity for Elizabeth to give an illustrated talk
- Research non-Quaker sources of funding for the Growing Together project and other African Great Lakes Initiative (AGLI) work
- Read some of what Elizabeth is reading about Rwanda and Burundi – appropriate development, solar technologies, sustainability, nutrition, child and maternal health, permaculture and organic horticulture, indigenous vegetables.... according to your interests – and discuss with Elizabeth.
- Visit Rwanda (and/or Burundi) while Elizabeth is there
- Find one or more people to take on the work and develop it when she stops – or volunteer yourself!
- Recruit volunteers for AGLI summer workcamps – or go yourself!
- Join the Ealing Meeting support group for Growing Together in Rwanda

You may be able to suggest something else - all suggestions will be considered.
